VINEYARD

History: La Batardière was built during the 17th century in order to give a place for the illegitimate (Batard in French) child of the neighboring “Seigneurie” lord. New Vines of Melon de Bourgogne were planted at la Batardière during the beginning of the 17th century.

Location on a small hill above the Sèvre river .

Age: 50-60 years old

Altitude: 220 meters high.

Pruning: Guyot double .

Harvest: Mechanical

Soil: Gabbro.

Name: Château de l’Oiselinière

Enologist Name: Fabrice Girardi

Winemaker notes: Selected from a parcel near an old Domain historically attached to l’Oiselinière, this wine is grown on lees during the whole winter and bottled at spring.

Varietal(s): Melon de Bourgogne

Tasting Notes: This is a fresh and lively wine with youthful aromas of apricots and hawthorn, maturing into mineral and melon. Crisp and pleasant, with a good length.
