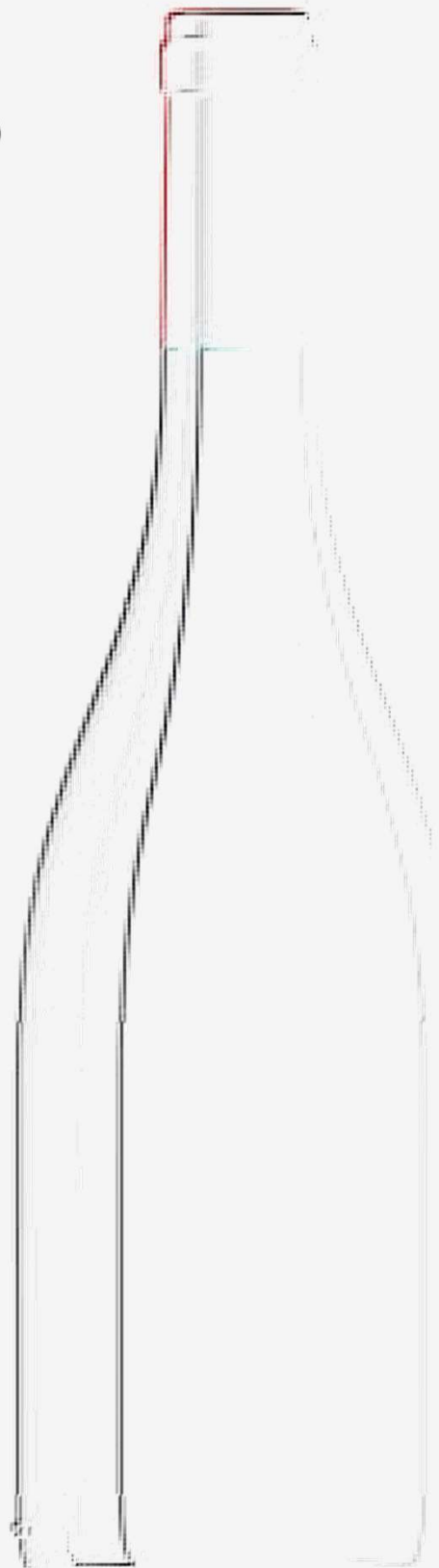

Tasting Notes: Honor Brut was born after a long and silent rest, with a thorough elaboration. Straw yellow color, fine and persistent bubbles, and bright appearance. Accentuated aroma of fresh grape with notes of ripe fruit and citrus, typical of aging in the bottle. In the mouth it has an important vivacity compensated by a pleasant balance and elegance.

Domaine de la Bastide Côtes du Rhône Rouge

Built on a Roman Villae, The Domaine de la Bastide is an old fortified Templar's farm with more than a thousand years old known records. Partly destroyed during the French revolution, it has now come back to its original aim: wine making. The cellar was built in the late 70's. Total capacity is more than 7500 hectolitres. Fermentation is conducted in stainless steel vats of 200 hectolitres with controlled temperature. After fermentation the wine is drained into concrete vats coated with epoxy resins. Vincent and Stephanie Boyer are the second generation operating this winery. They are currently practicing organic viticulture and hope to be certified in the near future.

The Domaine de la Bastide is located in the Rhône Valley, 50 km north of Avignon, in a little village called Visan. The vineyards are located in Visan and Suze-la-Rousse: most of them are on stony dry soils, typical of the South Rhône valley.

VINIFICATION : 80 % of the wine is obtain by pressing the grapes when it arrives at the winery. 20% are obtained by bleeding the tank after a period of 8 to 12 hours. Kept cold at about 8 °C for 48 hours drained to obtain clear juice. Fermented at 16°C

TASTING NOTES: Beautiful purple color, very deep reflections and brilliant purple. The nose has aromas of fresh red fruits, crushed strawberries and raspberries. On the palate we find a very nice balance, a wine that is fresh, dense and round. It is a fleshy wine, fruity and with good length.

Campo de Borja D.O., Fuendejalón, Spain

GRAPE VARIETIES

75% Old Vine Garnacha, 25% Old Vine Tempranillo

VINIFICATION

Grapes are harvested from vines an average of 25 years old. Each variety is vinified on its own. Maceration lasts 10 days in stainless steel tanks at 77° F. After 15 days of malolactic fermentation the wine is blended. Aged three months in a mix of used and new American oak casks. The final wine is bottle aged for a minimum of three months prior to release. *Vegan friendly.*

THE WINERY

Don Ramón is produced by Bodegas Aragonesas located in the small town of Fuendejalón, in the Spanish province of Aragón, for which it is named. Situated in the upper Ebro River Valley, and on the slopes of the Sierra Moncayo Mountains, it is the largest winery in Campo de Borja DOP. This is the ancestral home of Garnacha, where the extremely hot, dry climate and stark contrast between day and nighttime temperatures are ideal for cultivation of this late ripening variety. Garnacha vineyards are noted in the agricultural records kept by Cistercian Monks of the nearby Veruela Monastery, dating back to 1145. Today, the low yields of these century-old vines produce rich, concentrated wines with distinctive aromas and flavors. At all levels, they are approachable, balanced, smooth and fruity. At the same time, they are crafted with a sense of place and respect for the qualities that make Garnacha unique.

TASTING NOTE

This dry, medium bodied red wine is delicious and easy to drink, with bright aromatics, supple red fruit flavors, hints of vanilla and a soft, smooth texture with balanced acidity.

SERVING SUGGESTIONS

This versatile wine is excellent on its own or with anything from light cheeses and fish to roasted meats and vegetables.

ABOUT PROSECCO

Prosecco is a geographically protected wine producing area spanning the Veneto and Friuli regions. Its name originates from the Slovenian village of *Prosek* in the outskirts of Trieste. In the aftermath of WWI, the town was annexed by Italy, and its name changed to *Prosecco* which it remains named to this day. Prosecco must be produced from at least 85% Glera grapes. Although still Prosecco is produced in small quantities, most know of it in its sparkling form. Sparkling Prosecco is generally produced in the Charmat (capture) method. It undergoes this process for at least 30 days, and produces a soft, fruity, and festive wine.

ABOUT THE PRODUCER

Bellino Prosecco is produced the Sperone family, a fifth-generation wine-making family whose roots began in Vermouth production. A century ago, as the family business grew, production expanded to include table wines. The Sperone family is dedicated to producing authentic Italian wines at affordable prices.

VINIFICATION

Soft pressing and fermentation at controlled temperatures in stainless steel tanks using the Charmat method.

TASTING NOTE

A soft, dry sparkling white wine. Light and fruity with a round, full finish.

FOOD PAIRING

Ideal as an aperitif. Great with light hors d'oeuvres and fish entrées or as a complement to pastry.

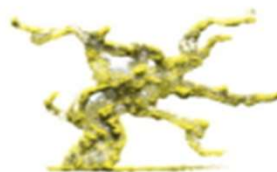

Vinification

Soft pressing, the must is left to ferment for 8-12 days at a low temperature in stainless vats. Then stored at 64-68 degrees F in stainless

Tasting Notes

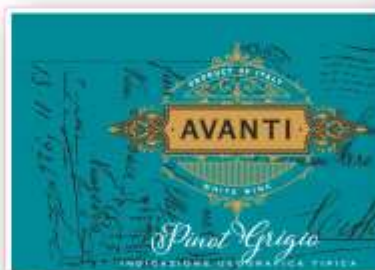

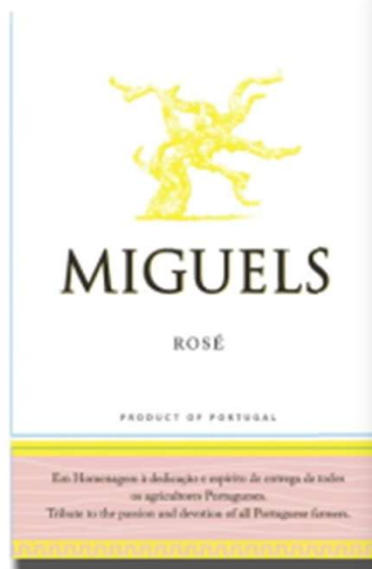

Tasting Notes:	This wine is made in a fruit forward style and intended for early release and consumption. The wine has delicious red fruit components of raspberry, strawberry and some stone fruit character. The wine has a soft round mouth-feel which offers up a hint of spice and a touch of bright acid to enhance a wide range of foods.
