

CHATEAU LAFFITTE CARCASSET SAINT ESTEPHE CRU BOURGEOIS

About Laffitte-Carcasset

The Saint-Estephe appellation consists of vineyards located in the south of the Medoc peninsula, upstream from the mouth of the Gironde estuary. This privileged geographical location combines with gravelly rises and a unique subsoil to product great wines. Laffitte-Carcasset is a Cru Bourgeois with 30 hectares of vines, mostly located around the chateau. Its name comes from Monsieur Joseph Laffitte who owned the estate in 1790.

Tasting Notes

The vineyard produces excellent wine with a remarkable bouquet and a great deal of finesse. This is thanks to a very propitious terroir and choice of premium grape varieties, including some very old vines.

Chateau Laffitte-Carcasset is faithful to its appellation; wellstructured and tannic, with an intense bouquet. It has fine ageing potential..
