



Château La Raze Beauvallet Cru Bourgeois Médoc

- Varietal:** 60% Cab Sauv, 34% Merlot, 5% Petit Verdot, 1% Cab Franc
- Appellation:** Médoc, Bordeaux. France
- Estate:** Civrac-en-Médoc
- Vinification:** Traditional
- Soil:** Rich in fossils from the Tertiary period.
- Cru Bourgeois:** Château La Raze Beauvallet has been listed as a Cru Bourgeois for over 60 years.
- Of Interest:** The château itself is a beautiful 19th century building. A very old and large underground cavity has been found underneath the park and this may have been used for pagan rituals before the Romanesque church was built nearby.
- Tasting Notes:** The careful attention given to both the growing and vinification processes gives this prestigious blend a most appreciated quality. This wine is a lovely purple-red color; its nose develops a pretty bouquet of blackberry notes and gingerbread. It is mellow and supple on the palate. It may be enjoyed now with grilled lamb, red meat and cheese.
