THE VINES

Sauvignon Blanc is the white wine grape variety that put Marlborough on the international wine map. Originating from western France, Sauvignon Blanc is now New Zealand's most planted variety and is successfully grown throughout all its wine regions.

TERROIR

The Marlborough Appellation wine region, at the northern tip of the South Island in the Wairau Valley has the reputation as one of the greatest Sauvignon Blanc regions of the world.

Low temperature fermentation. Unoaked, stainless steel.

Hei (verb) - To tie around the neck

Toki (noun) - Adze

The Hei Toki draws its origins from the revered stone tools used throughout Polynesia, deeply embedded in Māori tradition. The ceremonial toki poutangata, made from pounamu and intricately lashed onto carved wooden handles, were symbols of power and prestige, wielded by rangatira (Māori chiefs) during sacred ceremonies. These taonga, rich with mauri (life force), were cherished and passed down through generations, embodying the legacy of those who came before.
