

Pago wines have to be made exclusively with grapes from a single vineyard and both the winery and vineyard have to be in the same location. DOP Pago del Vicario was officially recognized by the European Union. It means they hold their own DO. Pago del Vicario is a unique vineyard located in an area with a special terroir and a microclimate, due to its proximity to the Guiadiana River. It is located in the Castilla-La Mancha region.

Refreshing fruity notes of grapefruit, lemon, pineapple and pear, aromatic herbs such as fennel, lavender, bay leaf and a mineral note. Full bodied and fresh with good acidity, citrus notes, fruity, crisp and saline notes that stimulate the palate. Highly persistent fruitiness reminiscent of tart strawberries.

Serve with cheese, fatty fish, seafood, white meats, pasta and rice.

Pago del Vicario 6 Meses is the clear expression of what a Vino de Pago means. Aged 6 months in barrel gives and intense taste leading to notes of coffee, chocolate and cinnamon. Fresh, fruity, silky, medium smooth aftertaste.
