

Ruhlmann Alsace wines are rooted in a rich winemaking tradition in Dambach-la-Ville, Alsace, France, dating back to 1688.

The wines come from Alsace, specifically Dambach-la-Ville and Scherwiller, with vineyards on granite-heavy soils (e.g., Rittersberg, Frankstein) and volcanic sediments

(Muenchberg). These terroirs impart minerality, finesse, and fruit-forward profiles. The continental climate and sunny hillsides enhance grape ripening.

The Estate emphasizes sustainable viticulture, with certifications like Terra Vitis and Haute Valeur Environnementale. Ruhlmann-Schutz is transitioning to organic farming, managing 70 hectares (40 in Alsace). They blend tradition (manual harvesting, oak barrels) with modern techniques (state-of-the-art equipment).
