A cooperative is a group of wine grape growers who share their resources to produce, bottle, and market wine. Making wine independently requires investment and time that is practically beyond the means of most farmers. Cooperatives play an essential role by providing growers with access to economies of scale, a vocal role in production, and a fair share of profits.

This approach also provides a tremendous benefit to consumers. Well-run cooperatives, like Moselland, are a prime source of excellent wine at lower prices. Moselland was formed in 1968 when several small cooperatives merged. It is now based in the famous twin wine towns of Berkastel-Kues, in the heart of the Mosel River Valley. Moselland produces wines from all over Germany in a range of styles, and Riesling in their specialty.



Sun Garden Riesling

Light golden in color with lovely aromas of citrus and honey. Off-dry with juicy peach, apple and key lime flavors, highlighted by crisp acidity and delicate minerality. Serve well chilled as a complement to lighter preparations of fish, chicken and spicy food.



Sun Garden Dornfelder

Tantalizing aromas of elderflower and cherry precede a rush of juicy berry flavor in this quaffable wine. Soft, lush and lightly sweet, it is smooth with a lovely crisp finish. For perfect enjoyment, serve chilled with cheese or spicy foods. Makes a delightful picnic companion.
