Torrevieja Malbec Reserva UCO Valley, Mendoza, Argentina



Region

The combination of high elevation, alluvial soils, irrigation sourced from the Andes Mountains, a long growing season with over 250 sunny days a year, little rain and vast temperature differences between day and night are all conducive to growing quality wine grapes. These climate and geography elements come together to provide excellent fruit ripening and concentration, developing colors, aromas, flavors and textures resulting in wines that are deep in color, intense in aromas and rich in flavors.

Tasting

Dark ruby red with elegant purple shimmers. The intense, long and expressive aromas of red fruit, mingle onto the palate with the clear taste of raspberry and black cherry, while also offering some coffee and chocolate accents on a lengthy finish.
