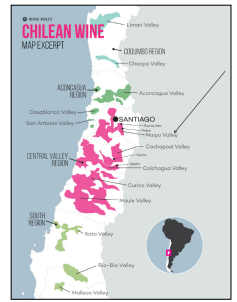


TREWA



The Alto Maipo sub-region is located in the foothills of the Andes, rising from 1,300 to 2,600 feet, and is strongly influenced by the mountainous climate with great variation of temperature between night and day.
