

Domaine Chaumeau-Balland

Sancerre 2022

Lying at the heart of Sancerre is the small and prestigious town of Bué. Multiple generations of the Chaumeau family have been producing superior Sancerre from 11 hectares of Sauvignon Blanc and 3 hectares of Pinot Noir.

Today, Anais Chaumeau manages the estate and the winemaking. Adding to the long list of **female estate owners and wine makers**.

The property extends along the rolling hills with vineyards scattered among the different exposures offered by the hills.

With an average vine age of 30 years, the vineyards surrounding the village, can attribute a large portion of their success to the Kimeredgian ridge, a geological feature that surfaces in Champagne, Chablis, and Sancerre. These famous regions all benefit from the unique limestone and clay soils that contribute to the body and mineral-driven flavor profile of their wines.

Chaumeau-Balland's vineyards are composed of "Caillottes" gravel giving the wine a crisp, clean, intense, and flavorful profile.
